

DENTON COUNTY RECLAMATION & ROAD DISTRICT

Management Report

November 4, 2010

1. My recovery continues to proceed satisfactorily and I have been able to visit the District several times in the past month with John's and Ann's assistance. I can drive again starting November 8.
2. John and I have made a detailed inspection of all District Facilities and the following facilities need attention this Winter or next Spring:
  - A. Overall, the Levee grassing is the best we have had for quite a while. Unfortunately, the grass also grows where we don't want it.
  - B. The Levee Road behind Riverglen Subdivision (across Hebron Pkwy from Oakwood Springs) has too much grass on it. It must be graded and probably have some road base added. This section of Levee is one (1) mile long.
  - C. Other parts of the Levees also need grading to remove grassing. This work is relatively minor.
  - D. There has been a substantial increase in the amount of vegetation in the Main East Drainage Channel. It needs cleaning out and 2-3 small beaver dams removed.
  - E. I will get bids to do this work as separate Projects. None of these are urgently needed but are parts of a regular maintenance program.
3. The piece of equipment the Contractor needs to cleanout the three (3) Drainage Channels has finally been completed and is due to arrive here early next week. He will promptly begin the Cleanout Project.
4. I will contact the Pump #2 Contractor before the Meeting and advise him that the Pump must be shown to have no damage due to their error in not properly returning it with all the parts full of grease. To do so, the Pump would have to be pulled and dismantled to prove no damages. I'll report at the next meeting.
