Management Report

May 11, 2010

1. TXU/ONCOR: There has been no further word on the Power Bill, primarily because ONCOR did not check their meter until May 5th and still has not checked their records. More information may be available at the Meeting. We have not received any additional billings.
2. We are still looking for someone to clean up the trash around the Sump Lake. Sperling agreed to remove the logs from the Sump when he mows late next week. If you know of anyone who does vegetation trash collection, please contact me.
3. We will transfer \$215,775.00 to Bank of New York on May 27 to pay the Bonds on June 1, 2010.
4. NTTA met me to inspect the erosion under SH121 Bridge and agreed to repair the erosion. This will save the District \$15,000-20,000+.
5. We had a complaint about an old trampoline dumped by the alley and sent a demand letter to remove it. The owner complied with the notice. The homeowner who reported this also inquired why we were keeping the water so high in the main Drainage Channel behind his house. He is mainly concerned about safety and flooding. I assured him that was not a concern but that the water level had been higher this year because of the Corps of Engineers Release procedures for Lake Lewisville keeping 8-9 feet of water in the River. I assured him we constantly monitor River Sump and Channel levels.
6. We did not pump in April. There was a total of 1.74" of rain which we disposed of by gravity flow.
7. I met with the chief of the Pump repairs in the Pump Station to check out the floor level of the Pump Station, proposed grouting and methods of stabilizing Pump. The Pump is ready when the Impellor is completed now estimated for early June.
