Management Report

July 8, 2011

1. The Pump Crew will be back next week to clean up the grout installation and related work. Now we wait until it rains.
2. Channels B and C have been completed and the Project will be presented for payment at the Board Meeting.
3. Request for Bids have been sent to Lander (did Channels A,B,C) and Texas Dirt (the 2nd low bidder for A,B,C). I am working to have Bids to submitted at the Board Meeting. They must specify a start and finish dates and will be penalized if they are late, unless it is due to weather. It should be completed before the end of the District's Fiscal Year on 9-30-11. The availability of a free disposal site should produce good bids.
4. The drought is very hard on the Levees and usually causes large cracks which can result in slides if there is a hard rain. The grass has quit growing but there are some weeds.
5. The Meridian Apartment House took bids to repair their fence that Sperling Mowers damaged and it will cost \$950.60 to repair. The Mower and I both think it is a fair amount. We kept \$500 from the Mower's fee for the last mowing and will deduct \$450.60 from their next mowing.
