

DENTON COUNTY RECLAMATION & ROAD DISTRICT
Management Report
May 8, 2009

1. Barring adverse weather, it appears that the Pump can be installed on May 12. After further investigation by the Contractor who looked into the matter, there now appears to be little justification to use the Shop Logs. We can drain the Lake to 1 ½ feet. The Stop Logs only allow about 2 feet of water to remain in the Lake. The little difference does not seem to justify \$8,000+ expense, but it is up to you. Please advise me of your thinking in case we have to do something before the Meeting. (It may take all day to get to where this decision is needed).
2. Two more taxpayers have inquired whether they could pay out their taxes over a period of time. Please be giving thought to guidelines and requirements if it will be allowed. The recommended way to do this is to have the taxpayer sign a note so if payments are not made, the District can sue on the note. This costs less than a separate tax suit. (Taxes are normally combined in a large number because costs discourage single suits).
3. We need to discuss the Pump Station and Site improvements. It cannot be started until at least July, but preplanning is recommended, particularly to establish a budget. Also a budget needs to be established for drainage channel cleanouts so we can establish a priority of channels.
