First, for most taxpayers 2008 District Taxes are 15% less than they were in 2007.

Second, the District expects there will be further reductions in the District's Taxes in 2009.

Third, the District will make significant improvements and upgrades to its equipment and facilities in 2009. This will not only continue our commitment to provide superior flood protection but it will also improve the District's 30 acre Sump Lake site to become a Community amenity.
